Carpenter has spent the past year performing alongside world-renowned orchestras since the release of her debut orchestra album, *Songs from the Movie*, which was conducted and arranged by six-time Grammy Award winner Vince Mendoza. Carpenter's world debut orchestral concert took place on January 24, 2014, at the Glasgow Royal Concert Hall alongside the BBC Symphony Orchestra and conducted by Mendoza. In March, she performed two milestone

concerts at New York's Lincoln Center with the New York Philharmonic and was joined by special guests Joan Baez, Shawn Colvin, Jerry Douglas, Tift Merritt, and Aoife O' Donovan.
