Lovett has been touring in support of *Release Me* since its release in February. The album was #1 for several weeks on the Americana charts. Produced by Nathaniel Kunkel and Lovett, *Release Me* represents the end of an era, as it was his last record for Curb/Universal Music Group after being on the label for his entire career. *Release Me* is quintessential Lovett, mixing a smart collection of originals and songs written by some of his favorite songwriters that show not only the breadth of this Texas legend's deep talents, but also the diversity of his influences, making him one of the most infectious and fascinating musicians in popular music.
