On Saturday, October 31, the McCoy Center will host a special community Halloween celebration screening of *Ghostbusters*, utilizing the Mershad Digital Experience, a state-of-the-art, digital projection and sound system that delivers superior brightness and color rendering, digital surround sound, and a full-immersion experience. Per the Governor's order, the audience will be limited to 15% of capacity and patrons will be asked to follow safety protocols including socially distanced seating and mandatory face coverings.

Tickets are limited to a maximum of 118.

2020 McCoy Safety Protocols

- Patrons, staff, and volunteers are asked to practice social distancing and must wear face masks/coverings at all times.
- Tickets must be pre-purchased online at www.mccoycenter.org and are limited to a maximum capacity of 118.
- Seating will be pre-assigned to maintain social distancing protocols. Groups larger than four people must be from the same household.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available in the lobby and outside restrooms.
- Concessions will not be offered.
- Doors will open 30 minutes prior to the screening beginning.
- The McCoy will employ enhanced, deep-cleaning procedures before and after the screening and increase the fresh air intake through the HVAC system.
- Those exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms or who may have been exposed to someone presenting symptoms in the 14 days prior to the screening are asked not to attend.
